

Parish Council Meetings

Councillors, further to my recent email regarding procedures during the present situation it is customary in May to have the Annual Parish Council meeting and the Annual residents meeting.

However, in the present situation the Government has advised that such meetings are no longer required and they have legislated accordingly. Similar advice has also come from LALC. I have discussed this with fellow Clerks from neighbouring villages and confirmed that their Councils are acting in a similar way.

I will continue to deal with PC correspondence from Chorley BC, Lancashire CC, and other bodies so that you are kept fully informed. Planning applications will be circulated and any invoices requiring payments will be circulated and cheques signed by three members as is normal. The payments will be confirmed when meetings resume. I have been sent the Annual External Audit papers from PKF Littlejohn and am in the process of completing them. You will be sent details before it is dispatched.
